to people who experience homelessness Help people transition into housing ASAP



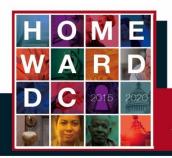






# **Features in Design**


- Outdoor playground and recreational space
- Age appropriate indoor recreation space
- Computer Labs
- Programming / Services Space
- Mini-Fridges in each room, with microwaves and sinks on each residential floor
- All Sites are ADA Accessible





# **The Current Projection on Bathroom Configuration**

- Increases private bathrooms to 15% of units.
- No congregate, multi-fixture bathrooms
- Current ratio of 1 family bathroom for every 2 families
